Our program offers online educational and wellness classes facilitated by Ohana Center staff, partner organizations, or local business owners to bring awareness and exposure to activities such as yoga, sound baths, spoken word and creative arts, which are traditionally not affordable or experienced by under-resourced communities.

Our Objective

The objective of the E.A.R.T.H. Program is to provide accessible resources to the most vulnerable populations of all ages who are at risk of developing serious mental health conditions. These resources decrease ongoing stress, prevent mental health issues, and decrease social isolation, while helping to build psycho-social skills.

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E.A.R.T.H. Program


Our program participants report that by participating in our online classes they feel a sense of reduced social isolation due to the increased virtual interactions they have during class.

Through our E.A.R.T.H. Program we offer:


- Wellness kits;


